With over 30 years' experience of caring for older people, we have designed Brendoncare Otterbourne Hill to support couples facing the challenges of living with dementia day-to-day, offering reassurance, support and flexibility.

You may have been diagnosed with dementia or be supporting your partner at home, which can become more difficult as the condition progresses. We recognise that dementia has an impact on both of your lives in different ways and Brendoncare Otterbourne Hill is able to provide care, support and assistance to you both.

The whole building is designed to support people with dementia and help them live as independently as possible. The apartments are constructed to the Stirling Gold Standards in dementia design, which help those living with dementia find their way around and feel safe. Lighting, contrast of colours, orientation and security features have been carefully incorporated in to the homely environment.

The apartments are for rent to allow for the flexibility to meet your changing needs.

Our care team is onsite 24 hours a day if you need them. From assistance around the apartment with household tasks and personal care, to help getting your medication and support from healthcare professionals, our team is here to help you. Our care will be designed around your

particular care needs, making sure you receive the support you need. Respite and one-to-one care will mean that we can provide support at short-notice if required.

The community hub is a focal point on the site. It offers a range of services for you and visitors to enjoy, such as a restaurant, hairdresser, film showings and a winter garden. There is also a regular schedule of dementia-friendly clubs and activities.

In the care home at Brendoncare Otterbourne Hill we offer both nursing and dementia care. This enables provision for both planned and emergency respite care, meaning that those caring for their loved one with dementia can have some time to focus on their own needs. If someone is no longer able to be supported in their apartment, the care home offers an onsite alternative; their partner is still living in the same building and is able to continue being involved in their care on a daily basis.

Overview

- 15 two-bedroom and five one-bedroom apartments, all of which are fully accessible and designed to support people living with dementia
- Communal lounges and balconies on each floor for residents and their visitors to use
- Onsite community hub with a range of facilities and activities
- Onsite parking for residents
- Supported bathing facilities available in the onsite care home

Apartment specifications

- Fully-equipped kitchen with
 - high quality fitted units
 - built-in eye-level electric oven with grill
 - halogen electric hob
 - sink
 - washer/dryer
 - slimline dishwasher
 - fridge and freezer or combined fridge/freezer
 - boiler
- Fully-tiled and equipped shower room with
 - walk-in shower
 - shelving unit
 - shaver point
 - 'Jack and Jill' doors allowing two entrances into the shower room, one leading from the main bedroom

- The two bedroom apartments also have an additional WC/cloakroom
- Built-in wardrobes in the bedrooms
- Carpet throughout the apartment
- Gas central heating with low surface temperature radiators
- TV socket
- Telephone and broadband sockets
- Security features including
 - secure lock on the front door with night latch, spy hole and doorbell
 - double-glazed windows and key-operated window restrictors
 - wireless emergency call response system connected to the onsite care home with call points in the lounge, bedroom and bathroom
 - smoke and heat detector
 - outside lights
- Each apartment enjoys its own private terrace or balcony, as well as community gardens available onsite
- Storage for a mobility scooter (with further communal storage space on the lower ground floor)
- Internal fire detection system
- Apartments are unfurnished except for carpets, curtain batons and the white goods listed above

Care

Care and support packages from the onsite staff are available for residents in the apartments. These are designed around each person's needs and will include help with washing, dressing and household tasks such as cooking and cleaning.

Other help can include personal care and support for activities and recreation, allowing partners the opportunity to go out knowing their loved one is cared for and safe. Care can be provided as long as the resident's health allows this to be safely carried out in their home.

Both planned and emergency respite care will be available in the care home, subject to a room being available, enabling partners to have some time to enjoy a break or simply manage their own needs for a short period. Alternative support can be put in place if there is no respite room available.


