Downing House has been operating as an Abbeyfield Care Home for 25 years. In that time Downing House has been extended and improved to ensure it meets current standards and requirements. The Home's aim is to enable 23 older people to continue to live as independently as possible by receiving care and support consistent with their individual needs and preferences. We welcome applications from people from all walks of life regardless of background, gender, culture or beliefs. All residents are assured that they will be treated with dignity and respect and will be afforded recognition of their individuality at all times.

Downing House home is situated in Withington, which is on the outskirts of Manchester. The home has a garden with a lawn and patio area, along with a courtyard, and both are well maintained and offer residents and their visitors the opportunity to sit out when the weather is suitable. The local amenities are easily accessible by means of a 2-3 minute walk and Manchester is only a 20 minute bus ride.

Anyone who is over 65 years of age, male or female, who is assessed as needing help and support with their daily living can apply for a place at Downing House. We are able to offer care, support and accommodation in single rooms.

The home is not registered to provide nursing care or care for people whose primary needs relate to dementia
