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YOUR DESCRIPTION

Ferfoot is a purpose-built dementia care home comprising two self-contained units, enjoying an enviable position down a quiet, leafy lane within the historic town of Chippenham, Wiltshire. The well-presented approach to Ferfoot creates an especially welcoming impression, while the house itself offers striking views over the town to the rolling countryside beyond. Shops and other key facilities are within easy reach of the home.

The main building dates from 1902, and was originally a typical turn-of-the-19th-century family home in Wiltshire Stone. The house has benefited from several purpose-built extensions, which have all been constructed sympathetically and in full keeping with the original building.
