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YOUR DESCRIPTION

Pembroke Lodge is a large adapted Edwardian House, situated near the town of Reading. It has 14 bedrooms - 11 single and 3 shared rooms. Toilets and bathrooms are located on each of the three floors, including a bath with integral hoist and shower being available on the first floor. A vertical passenger lift provides access to all floors.

There is wheelchair access to the large secluded rear garden which has well-established trees and shrubs. Residents are encouraged to enjoy the garden, especially in the warmer months of the year. There is also a large patio area to the front of the garden with an awning to provide shade on those sunny days.
