YOUR DESCRIPTION

Linden House is a privately owned Residential Care Home. Originally a well known local hotel, situated between Epsom Town Centre and the world renowned Epsom Downs. The main train service to Victoria is within one mile.

Linden House was converted by the existing owner to the needs of the elderly in 1981, and the home offers single rooms all which have private en-suite facilities. Spacious communal areas consist of 3 large lounge/sitting rooms, a large hall area and 2 dining rooms. The home gives the image of a private hotel, with the added benefit of 24 hour care. The home has a warm, friendly and informal atmosphere with no restrictions on visiting hours. Parking is no problem as the home has its own private car park.

Over the years due to demand we have increased registration from 19 to 32 bedrooms. We are fully central heated and double glazed. The home has fire detection equipment fitted throughout, 3 purpose built bathrooms fitted with hoists, in-house laundry, and public telephone. There also is a beautiful secluded garden with ample seating areas,
