# YOUR DESCRIPTION

Parklands Court is situated in the suburb of Bloxwich, a residential area of Walsall. Local shops are within walking distance and the home is on a local bus route. This modern, purpose-built, single storey home, has been designed specifically to meet the needs of elderly residents. Parklands Court has five separate houses, three registered for nursing care and two for dementia care. Each house has a comfortable, well furnished lounge, conservatory and dining area which provides a central meeting place for residents to relax and entertain guests. All houses have access to the large landscaped gardens and patio area. Daily social activities are arranged including musical afternoons, gardening and games. The home also provides care for older people with physical disabilities, and those requiring palliative or terminal care. Parklands Court welcomes residents funded by the local authority.
