The Oaks Care Centre is an established Care Home in South London, conveniently placed on the A20. It is accessible from the M25 and the M20 and gives easy access to and from central London via the A20. The Home provides care for individuals suffering from organic brain disease (dementia), challenging behaviour and complex physical needs in a contemporary environment, reflective of current trends in dementia care. Individuals and their advocates, family and friends are encouraged to personalise individual rooms. The Home is divided into six seperate units over two stories and benefits from an on-site laundry facility, catering and extensive garden areas
