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YOUR DESCRIPTION

Croft Meadow is being purpose built and is due to open in May 2009 replacing the original home that was on the same site. It has been designed and built to a very high specification with a lot of thought going into its layout, access and sense of space. It exceeds all of the latest environmental standards for care homes as defined in the Care Standards Act.

All residents' bedrooms have full en-suite facilities comprising walk-in shower, W/C and handbasin. The home has six wings/units each with ten bedrooms, with two wings on the ground floor, first floor and top floor. Each wing has its own dedicated lounge/diner and assisted facilities.

An indoor 'Street/Gallery' runs the length of the building linking the wings to the facilities and making the home easy to get around. There are additional quiet communal spaces at the ends of the street and gallery and two passenger lift's and staircase.
