YOUR DESCRIPTION

Glebelands aims to provide a comfortable home in a caring environment, and is set in its own grounds near the centre of Wokingham in East Berkshire. All rooms have a lovely view of the grounds, a wash-basin, television and telephone and a refreshing cup of tea is brought to you every morning before breakfast. Expert care staff are on duty 24 hours a day including trained nursing staff, though Glebelands is not yet registered to accept those in need of nursing care.

The main house is a grade 2 listed large country house built in the late Victorian era and offers spacious wellappointed accommodation. The House has an atmosphere of calm and contentment while an air of gracious living pervades the extensive communal rooms. There is a library, cinema, bar, snooker room and a conservatory plus a rose garden within the extensive private gardens. There are 8 acres of rolling lawns, mature trees including a giant cedar and woodland, which provide a delightful setting for retirement or a holiday.
