# Specialist day services...

This service is provided by West Sussex County Council and is a specialist day service for people with longer term or complex social care needs.

We provide a wide range of day services which include support, activities and community opportunities that help adults to live as independently as they can and be a part of their own community to the best of their ability and in a way that is right for them.

We also offer a short-term service that helps people regain their independence and access support to meet their needs within the wider local community.

We recognise that everyone is individual and will have different needs, interests and goals. With this in mind, some of the opportunities will need to be met outside of the day centre building and in partnership with others.

# making everyday connections

## **Who is it for?**

The service is aimed at people with a physical, sensory or memory impairment and people with an acquired brain injury.

## **How can people access this service?**

People must meet our eligibility criteria for adult social care. Our staff can discuss this and explain our assessment process. Please see our office contact details on the back page of this leaflet.

## **Is there a charge for the service?**

People may need to make a financial contribution towards the cost of the care they receive. The amount will depend on their financial circumstances. We will discuss this with you when you first contact us.

## **What does the service provide?**

We provide a wide range of services, please see the following examples.

## **General services and support**

- A plan which details your agreed goals and support with regular reviews.
- An allocated member of staff who will support you in meeting your goals.
- A wide ranging activities programme.
- Workshops, theme days, talks and professional entertainment.
- Arrangements for professionals to visit people at day centres for example district nurse, physiotherapist and social care workers.
- A range of personal care services including toileting, changing facilities and, where available, a hairdressing service.
- Administering or supporting you to take your medication.
- Cooked meals and beverages.
- Advice on transport including using our specialist vehicles where appropriate.



## Specialist dementia services

- Up to five days a week with specialist trained staff.
- Individual plans with agreed goals.
- All customers are supported to engage with their local community to the best of their ability.
- Dementia Care Mapping (DCM) in place at all of the specialist dementia services. DCM is a process that allows trained staff to continually assess the quality of care for people with dementia and ensures focus on the needs of the individual.
- Working in partnership with other dementia agencies, for example, Alzheimer's Society.
- Information and advice for customers and carers.
- Carers support groups.

## Independence focused activities

- Short-term goal focused programmes.
- Acquired brain injury services.\*
- Information Technology suites.
- Mobility suites.\*
- Training kitchens.\*
- Confidence building programmes.

## Community connection

- Help to access employment, volunteer opportunities, leisure, education, faith based or other community based activities. We will do this in partnership with other organisations.
