There is a charge of £16.50/hour plus any associated costs such as transport, bus fares and entrance fees.

Our charity started out in 1986 with the name Ryder-Cheshire Volunteers. The first project in Oxfordshire was in Wallingford, South Oxfordshire, enabling people with a physical disability to enjoy leisure or learning activities of their choice.

We now operate in many counties of the UK. Each local branch is a separate charity, operating under the umbrella of our national organisation.

In 2012 we became ENRYCH, a name which reflects the changing ways we support and enrich the lives of individuals, whilst retaining our links with our founders Sue Ryder and Leonard Cheshire.

Our aim remains the same – to enable people with a physical disability to enjoy their lives, realise their potential, and achieve their outcomes.
