Dementia and Alzheimer's daily care

There are a number of different forms of dementia and it affects people in different ways. That is why it is so important that each client receives a knowledgeable professional service involving kindness and respect.

Many people with dementia find themselves categorised, often losing their individuality, when in fact, each have their own identity and it is only dementia they have in common. More often our care will be of a practical nature, support with getting up, washing or dressing or perhaps help with meals, and the little things to keep your house running. It may be about going out to the shops, a visit to relatives or friends, or a walk in the park.

Support service for family carers

Family carers, a spouse or a family member so often look after their loved ones with dementia, supporting them each and every day. Caring relatives need a break from time to time or regularly and in times of crisis and this is where our 'sitting service' can help. On an arranged day each week we will come and take over the role, allowing the family carer, time for themselves. Some of our clients may require live-in care, which is also available for short periods when they want to go away on holiday or longer.

Experienced support
