Vision Homecall provide a mobile service where we can check the health of your eyes and carry out your eye test at your convenience in the comfort of your own home.

We have all the latest portable equipment which enables us to do this.

A typical eye examination usually includes:

- A review of your eye and general health
- Your family medical history
- An examination of the ability of your eye muscles to work together
- Your intraocular pressure (this is your eye pressure which has to be within a certain range)
- A measure of your refraction to determine whether or not glasses are required.

You are eligible for a free NHS eye test if you have difficulty getting to a high street Optician without assistance and are:

- Aged 60 or over
- Registered blind or partially sighted
- Diagnosed as having Diabetes or Glaucoma
- Aged 40 or over with a direct relative with Glaucoma, or have been advised by an ophthalmologist that you are at risk of Glaucoma
- Prescribed a complex lens

You are also eligible if you or your partner are receiving any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and support allowance (ESA)
- Working Tax Credit and are named on a Tax Credit NHS Exemption Certificate
- Child Tax Credit and are named on a Tax Credit NHS Exemption Certificate
- You are named on a NHS certificate for full help with health costs
- Pension Credit Guarantee
