Why choose Homeshare?

- For householders, it helps you stay independently at home for longer
- For sharers, it offers affordable accommodation at a time of high rent and record housing shortages
- It gives you and your loved ones peace of mind, with an overnight presence and a safe and friendly home for both people.

Homeshare Support

Each Homeshare match has the back up of their local Homeshare organisation, which selects and approves them and individually matches their interests, lifestyle and hobbies. They complete security and householder checks and provide ongoing support to both people in the match.

Homesharing is not a rental service so a Homesharer doesn't pay rent. Instead household bills are split fairly. The Homesharer and Householder will both pay a fee to their local Homeshare organisation to cover the costs of their service and support.

Every Homeshare organisation is a member of Homeshare UK, the UK network for Homeshare, supported by Shared Lives Plus, the UK network for shared living.



This is a common sense approach that tackles two problems at once in a creative way. Loneliness is a hidden problem in our communities, and as well as providing more homes, this service will provide companionship and bring the different generations together.
