We aim to provide a wide range of flexible, person-centred services to meet the needs of people in later life in a happy and stimulating environment.

We have fully trained staff and volunteers who have undergone the appropriate police checks.

Our Day Services may help you to maintain your independence or help your carer provide the necessary help you need for longer.

What is the service?
