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Direct payments also referred to as self-directed support are cash payments made directly from your local authority to give you more flexibility, choice and control about who provides your care and when you receive it.

Some people may not always find services flexible enough to respond to their needs, or some people may feel that other services lack in continuity. If you are currently receiving a care package through your local authority you can still change to a direct payment at any time.

CLC employs Personal Assistant's (PAs) specifically to meet your individual needs. PAs provide tailor-made support to meet an individual's needs and outcomes. The tasks involved in a PA's job description can range from accompanying a disabled individual swimming or taking them shopping to more intimate needs such as feeding and personal care.

At CLC we believe in keeping things clear and simple as such our charges for the services we provide are clear and simple:

Low Level Support

£11.50 per hour

- Outings to the local community (shopping and going to the hairdressers).
- GP, hospital and dental appointments.
- Domestic support (light housework and cleaning).
- Companionship and befriending in the comfort of your own home.
- Assistance with getting in and out of bed.
- Meal preparation.

Medium Level Support

£12.50 per hour

- Support with washing, bathing and dressing.
- Personal care.
- Supervision and prompting of prescribed medication.
- Support provided when discharged from hospital (including support in preparing your home for equipment and adaptations)
- Sleepovers and waking night care.

High Level Support

£14.50 per hour

- High dependency and care needs involving Personal Assistants to require specific and intensive training for the health needs of an individual.
- High levels of support with sensitive personal care needs such as toileting, continence care, washing and bathing.
- Personal Assistant working with other agencies, including District Nurses and other healthcare professionals to provide more health care services.

Our services are charged and invoiced to you or your third party managed account based on the number of hours worked by the Personal Assistant, our services range from 30 minutes 'pop-in' to 24 hour care.

We believe individuals and their families should be involved and participate in the creation of their own personalised care packages, so we offer a free consultation to create a person-centred support plan to get to know you and understand your needs.

Our support plans can also assist you with applying for your direct payment or a personal budget from your local social services.
