Quality Assurance

We are committed to ensuring the homecare team are meeting our own exacting standards. A rigorous quality performance system is embedded across A Class Care through which our Quality Performance Manager performs thorough monthly audits, bimonthly inspections and annual surveys.

We also formally review the programme of care every six months or earlier should a need arise. We appreciate that things change, including Health & Mobility, and we want to ensure that the care provisions capture any changes and the service meets our clients' exact needs.

Like all registered domiciliary care providers, we are subject to independent inspections and monitoring. The Care Quality Commission (CQC) regulates the care sector and its inspectors perform a thorough, unannounced investigation at least once each year. This ensures that we are achieving the regulated outcomes under the essential standards of quality and safety.

A Class Care provides a client folder that remains within the home. The folder details every aspect of care provision.

Examples of documents included are:

- A daily journal detailing the duties that were performed on the day
- Risk assessments
- Daily activities
- Diary of food and fluid intake
- Domestic duties performed
- Medication log

The client folders are screened by our conscientious Registered Manager. This provides peace of mind that you or your loved ones are being meticulously looked after, with both precision and care.

RECRUITMENT

All our staff are trained in fire safety, health and safety, safeguarding adults, care and administration of medicines, palliative care and infection control to name but a

Our staff are regularly supervised and observed delivering care in the homes of our clients by a senior member of the team. We will always ask your permission in advance if we plan to undertake an observation in your home.
